


Google Recaptcha V2 API Keys Setup Guide

Configure **Google Recaptcha** keys under **Admin > Settings > General settings >Third party API** . (fig 1)

To collect these keys, Follow below steps:

1. Login to your Google Account, If you don't have one, create a new Google Account and Login. Then visit <https://www.google.com/recaptcha/admin/create>


Fig. 2: Google reCaptcha Homepage

2. You'll be redirected to **Google reCaptcha** page.(fig 2)

3. In this form add:

- **Label:** Enter label as per the provided format.
- **reCAPTCHA type:** select reCAPTCHA v2 (further select **"I'm not a robot"** which may be selected already)
- **Domains:** Add the domains as per the provided format.
- **Owners:** Enter the email addresses to be linked.
- **'Accept the reCaptcha Terms of Service' Check-box:** Select this check-box to accept the terms of service.

- **'Send Alerts to Owners' Check-box:** Select this check-box if they wish to receive alerts.

Click on the **'Submit'** button to finish registering the new site. (fig 3)

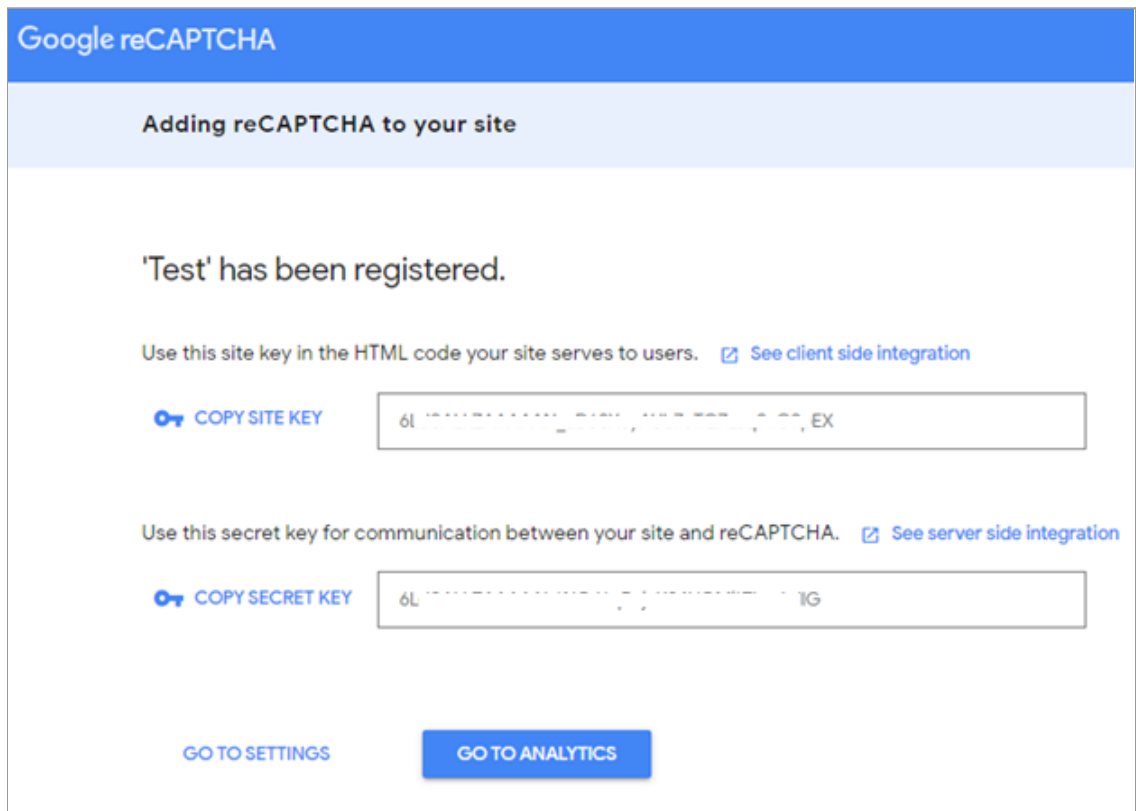


Fig. 4: Adding reCaptcha to Your Site

4. Next, **Adding reCaptcha to Your Site** page will open. (fig 4)
