

Fixer Currency Converter API Configuration

Guide

Fixer is an advanced currency and exchange rate API platform that delivers latest exchange rate data for all or a specific set of currencies. Its other features include converting amounts from one currency to another, retrieving time-series data for one or multiple currencies and querying the API for daily fluctuation data.

To configure the Fixer Currency Converter API plugin, go to **Manage Settings > Currency Management > Configuration**.

The Fixer API is capable of delivering real-time forex data via API at an accuracy of 6 decimal points and a frequency as high as every 60 seconds. Fixer is built on top of a powerful back-end infrastructure allowing for high availability and response times below 50ms for specific API requests. Capabilities include delivering exchange rates for 170 world currencies, converting single currencies, returning Time-Series data, and fluctuation data.

Learn how to get the **Fixer API Key** by following the steps below:

1. Visit [https://fixer.io/](https://fixer.io) to begin the sign up process.

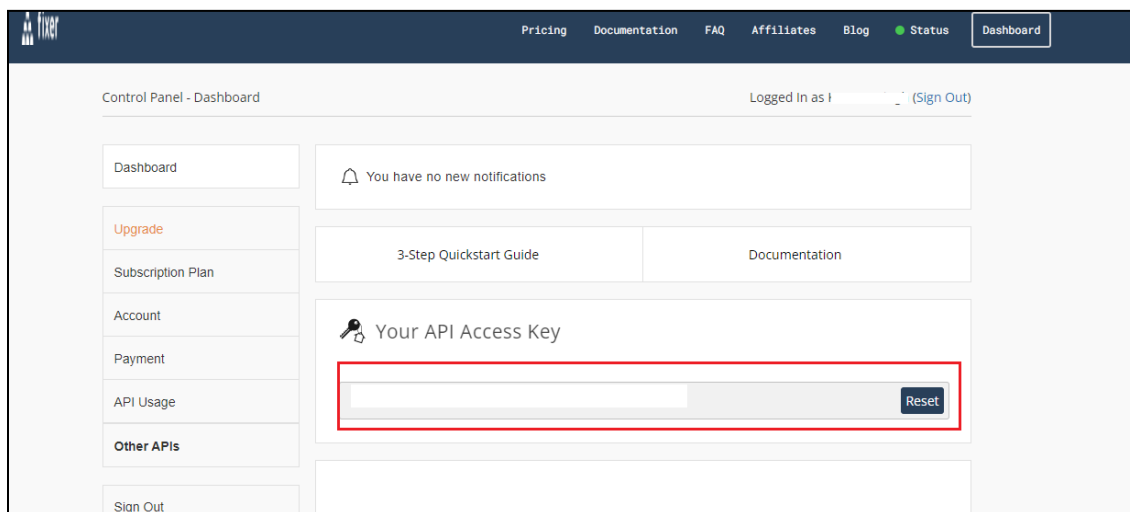
Asterisk (*) next to a form control's label indicates it as 'required'.

2. Click on **Sign Up Free** and you are redirected to the **Fixer API Plans** page.

Select a plan as per your requirement and follow the instructions to complete the sign in process.

3. Once you are logged in, the **Dashboard** page is opened.
4. Locate the **access key** displayed under the **Your API Access Key** section.



5. Lastly, copy the access key using the keyboard shortcut **(Ctrl+C)**. Another way through which keys can be copied is through right mouse click and selecting the **copy** option. Once it's done, paste the keys into the **Manage Settings > Currency Management > Configuration** form.



If the free key is configured, set **EUR (Euro)** as the **Default Base Currency** for the plugin to work. There is no such restriction when configuring the paid API key.
